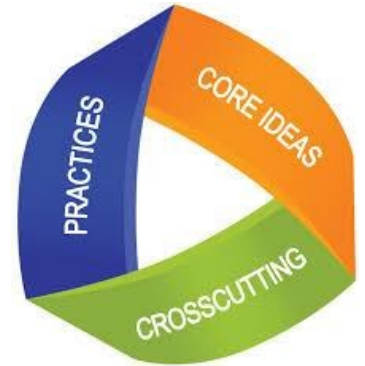


NGSS Conceptual Flow: Bridging the Gap between Standards, Instructional Materials, and Student Learning
