Thank you for attending our Summit to build up the San Luis Obispo Community. Over 120 community members, students, parents, members of law enforcement, government officials, legislative representatives, and educators joined together to share proactive next steps in building community.

Our day began with three student speakers, an address from our Sheriff, a representative from Bank of America's Foundation established post Columbine, and Tony Milano from RADHUMAN.

Table groups discussed the following:

- 1) Share one experience with personal or agency-disconnect that preceded conflict, concern, or crisis.
- 2) Share one question that is raised when thinking about personal or agency-disconnect that preceded conflict, concern, or crisis.
- 3) Share one proactive option that might mitigate personal or agency-disconnect to prevent conflict, concern, or crisis.
