MISSION STATEMENT

SIPE's mission is to provide a quality workers' compensation program and a comprehensive, proactive risk management program that promotes the health and safety of employees and protects the assets of the member school districts.

THE ORGANIZATION

Schools Insurance Program for Employees (SIPE) is a joint powers authority (JPA) established in 1977 to provide the services necessary for the operation and maintenance of a self-insurance system for workers' compensation coverage for the public school districts, County Office of Education, and Community College of San Luis Obispo County. SIPE's self-insurance system for workers' compensation consists of:

- Safety, loss control, and industrial hygiene services
- Safety and risk management research and development
- Sponsorship of educational programs to benefit and enhance all district safety programs
- · Claims administration

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors consists of one representative from each member district. The board officers include the President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary, who serve as the executive committee to provide direction to the Executive Director.

THE RISK MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

The Risk Management Committee functions as a safety research and development committee for the Board of Directors. The Risk Management Committee assists with emergency preparedness planning and compliance with the California Code of Regulations, including but not limited to Title 8, Accident Prevention Program, and written Injury & Illness Prevention Program.

SERVICES

SIPE offers a variety of valuable services geared toward its mission. In addition to workers' compensation insurance, our loss control team works with each member school district to provide programs designed to encourage safety awareness and compliance through loss control plans, training, inspections, evaluations, safety committee participation, and consultations, which ultimately reduces claims and the associated costs.
