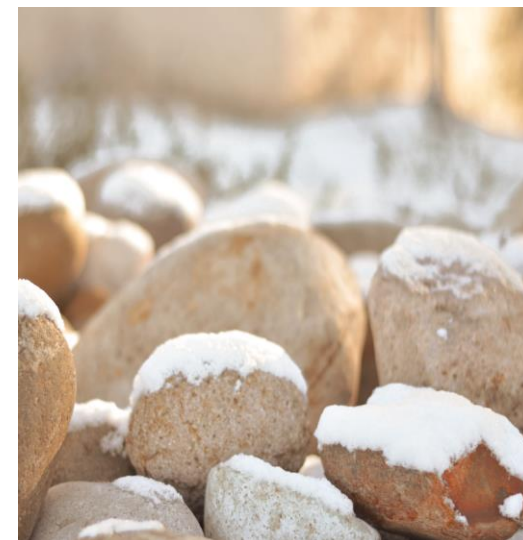

Native NetWORKS Program

Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act (WIOA)

Provides career training, job exploration, computer training, educational and counseling services, as well as supportive services to overcome barriers in employment.

Individuals develop job readiness skills to become more competitive in the workforce such as:

- Individualized Training with Career Advocates
- Mock Interviews
- Resume and Cover Letter Development
- Job Placement Assistance
- Career Training and Workshops
- Financial Planning and Budgeting
- Trainings for QuickBooks, Microsoft Office and Access, and Basic Computer Knowledge

HOWKA Program

Community Service Block Grant Program

Provides emergency services for eligible low income Natives and their families living in urban communities in SCAIR's service areas.

Services Includes:

Food, Transportation Services, Clothing, Rent, Utilities, Medical Assistance, and other related services to improve standards of living.

Tribal TANF Program

Provides Tribal TANF participants with career training, educational training, personal development training, counseling services, and specialized workshops and trainings for eligible Natives and their families. Call Tribal TANF for more information: (866)-913-3725.

Sacred Pipe Tobacco-Use Prevention Education (TUPE)

Provides services for Native children (K-12).

Promotes commercial tobacco prevention education, smoking cessation, cultural training and education on usage of tobacco in ceremonies, medicine, and health and wellness.



American Indian Education Center (AIEC) Program

Provides academic tutorial services and counseling services to Native children (K-12) and their parents.

Academic Tutorial Services includes:

- One on one academic assistance
- College preparation
- GED/Diploma/HiSET Test Preparation
